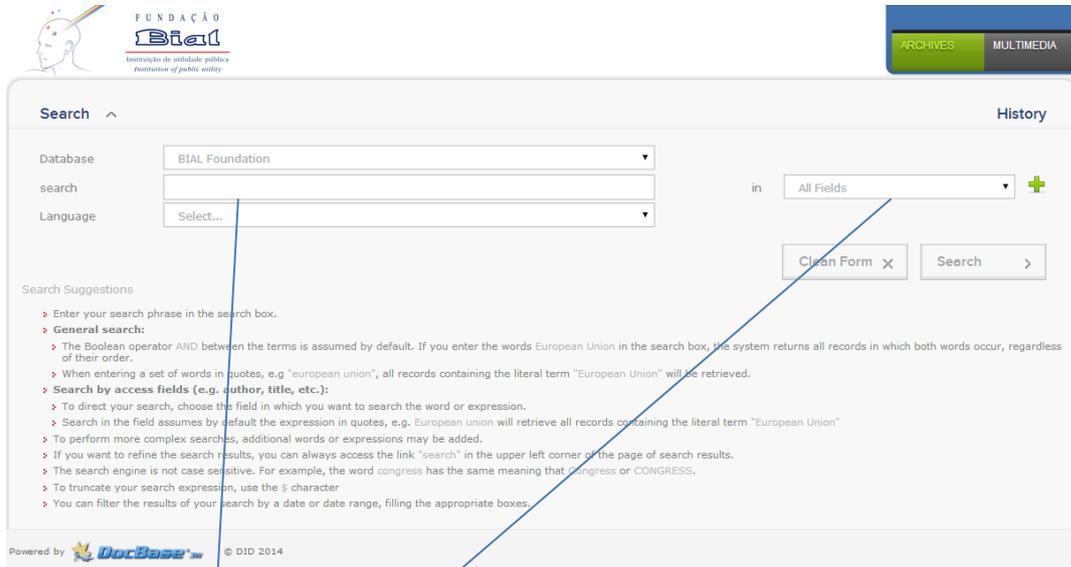


**Docbweb - Online search of the BIAL Database: <http://docbasecloud/bial>**



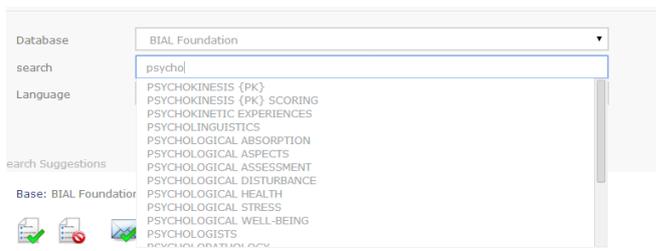
Entering the webpage, you can select the **Field** you want to search by selecting this box



- All Fields** – the search will be performed in all fields
- Authors** – search by author, last name, first initial of name
- Keywords** – search by keywords defined in the documents
- Titles** – search by document title
- Reference code** – univocal code that locates the document within the hierarchical structure into which it is organized (PT/FB/BL-2002-020 Bursary corresponding to File 20 of 2002, PT = Portuguese Archive, FB =Fundação Bial, 2002 year of Bursary; 020 = number of file; 020.01 = Final report, 020.02 = document/paper attached to file.
- Hierarchy level** – Search by hierarchical level: Supercat – Fund / Sub-Cat– Section / Category – Series / File – File / Document – Document



If you insert search words in this box, the keyword index will be shown below



If you select a term and click on Search, you can add more boxes in order to refine your search by clicking



If you select Parapsychology and Psychokinesis (PK) with the boolean operator OR, 876 records will be retrieved

If you use the boolean operator AND, only the records that associate both keywords will be retrieved, i.e. 83 records

	<b>Abstract/Results:</b>	ABSTRACT: Five survey studies, three conducted from 1995 to 1997 and two more in 2007 and 2008, are reported in which we hypothesised that individuals who claimed to be "aura viewers" would report a higher frequency of other seemingly psychic, mystical and lucid dream experiences and a higher number of discrete psychic experiences than "non-aura viewers." For Studies 2 through 5, it was also hypothesised that aura viewers would obtain a similar relationship with synaesthesia-like experiences and with measures of dissociation (using the Dissociative Experiences Scale), absorption (using Tellegen's Absorption Scale), and depersonalisation (using the Cambridge Depersonalisation Scale). The studies also differed in terms of the language of administration (either Spanish or English) and study populations (from special interest groups to college students to members of the general public). In all five studies, the main hypotheses were confirmed with the exception of lucid dreams, a significant difference between the groups being found only in Studies 3
