


2. Mirco-phenomenology






- Select trial with [+] or [-] potential
- Interrupt the task



- Interviews in [+] and [-] condition
- Researcher is blind to condition
- What is it like to make "free decisions" in the Libet task?
- Can interviews distinguish between [+] and [-] trials?
- Is a rising potential associated with an "urge to act"?



17 pairs of interviews 10 correctly identified p = 0.31
